

## GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

Contributors can submit their research papers according to APA (American Psychological Association) 2016 style for references and contributors are requested to submit their paper up to 31<sup>st</sup> October for the Issue of December and 31<sup>st</sup> March for the Issue of June. No paper will be printed after due date. Paper must be followed by the title of the paper, name of the author, designation, affiliation with the institution and place. There after it must be followed by abstract (300 words maximum), keywords (5 minimum), manuscript of paper and references as mentioned above. The paper must be typed in Times New Roman font size 12 for English medium. No paper will be considered if not in the prescribed format. Every contributor has to submit a certificate of originality or actuality which is enclosed herewith. Only prescribed format for the research paper will be applicable for the print of paper.
